



Crime Victim Therapist (Child)

Responsibilities:

Provides therapy sessions, crisis intervention counseling, assessment, referrals and follow-up medical and legal advocacy to child and youth victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, and other interpersonal crimes. These services may include assessment, treatment, planning and intervention, forensic interviewing, appropriate referrals to social services, medical and mental health agencies, and other community resources. Although the incumbent will also work with adults, the work is distinguished from that of a Crime Victim Therapist in that the incumbent is assigned primarily to child victims of crime and is experienced in child therapy. Work is performed under the general supervision of a Clinical Supervisor. Does related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

At least a Master's Degree in counseling, clinical social work or closely related field AND, EITHER:

1. Six (6) months of experience conducting individual therapy with children and adolescents; OR,
2. Successful completion of a master's level internship with a rape crisis or victim assistance program.

Special Requirement:

1. Eligibility for and possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment;
2. Must be licensed or have applied for licensure from NY State as an LMSW, LCSW or LMHC within six (6) months of appointment.
3. Successful clearance of the required Suitability Determination (Background investigation is conducted by the appointing authority.)
