Responsibilities:

This is professional work involving responsibility for administering and supervising the social work services of a community mental health program. This worker can be assigned to supervise a team of workers in a specialized treatment or clinical setting such as Intensive Care, the Mobile Crisis Team, Children, Adults or Alcohol and Substance Abuse or the Correctional Facility. On occasion, this worker may carry a caseload in addition to administrative and supervisory responsibilities. The work is performed under the general supervision of a Clinical Director. Does related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

Possession of a Master's degree in Social Work from a graduate school of social work approved by the NYS Education Department or regionally accredited institute and two (2) years of professional experience in social work in a Community Mental Health program. Must be a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW).
