## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Provides therapy sessions, crisis intervention counseling, assessment, referrals and follow-up medical and legal advocacy to child and youth victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, and other interpersonal crimes. These services may include assessment, treatment, planning and intervention, forensic interviewing, appropriate referrals to social services, medical and mental health agencies, and other community resources. Although the incumbent will also work with adults, the work is distinguished from that of a Crime Victim Therapist in that the incumbent is assigned primarily to child victims of crime and is experienced in child therapy. Work is performed under the general supervision of a Clinical Supervisor. Does related work as required.

# **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

At least a Master's Degree in counseling, clinical social work or closely related field AND, EITHER:

- A. Six (6) months of experience conducting individual therapy with children and adolescents; OR,
- B. Successful completion of a master's level internship with a rape crisis or victim assistance program.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Eligibility for and possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment;
- 2. Must be licensed or have applied for licensure from NY State as an LMSW, LCSW or LMHC within six (6) months of appointment.
- 3. Successful clearance of the required Suitability Determination (Background investigation is conducted by the appointing authority.)

Apply online at the Current Job Opportunities tab of the Albany County Civil Service Portal. Cover Letter and resume required. Resumes, cover letters, transcripts and licenses/certifications can be uploaded to the application before completing submission.

Candidates will not have to take an exam for this title. This is a Hiring Emergency Limited Placement (HELP) Program-designated title. The HELP Program is a temporary program designed to help local government employers address current staffing issues. Traditionally, the titles filled under the HELP Program required job candidates to compete in a competitive exam to be considered for employment. For the duration of the program, this title will be classified as non-competitive and categorized as a "HELP Program" position. At the close of the program, this position will revert toompetitive class status. Employees occupying positions filled through the HELP Program will be granted competitive class status without the need to participate in a competitive exam.
