DESCRIPTION:

The position is responsible for maintaining accurate employee data, including personal information, employment details, benefits, and payroll. They oversee HRIS operations, including data integrity, system updates, and user access. This role will create and analyze reports for HR decision-making and compliance, provide technical assistance to HR staff and other users on system usage and modify the HRIS to align with HR policies and procedures. Incumbent will educate HR personnel on the system's features and best practices, resolve technical problems and issues related to the HRIS and also ensure data integrity, security, and compliance with regulations. This position will identify opportunities to streamline HR processes, improve system efficiency and collaborate on integrating the HRIS with other software systems. They will also ensure compliance with data privacy and security protocols, assist with HR projects involving data management, work flows, and system enhancements and also act as a liaison between HR, IT, and other relevant departments.
