## **DESCRIPTION:**

This is a skilled position involving the repair and preventative maintenance of mechanical systems at wastewater facilities with a focus on the maintenance of multiple hearth sewage sludge incinerators. Duties involve responsibility for independently performing a variety of skilled repair and maintenance tasks on electrical, mechanical, pneumatic, hydraulic, HVAC equipment and monitoring instruments. In addition, the incumbent performs specialized maintenance and repair work on multiple hearth sewage sludge incinerators and associated ancillary systems including but not limited to burners, motors, pumps, conveyors, electric, hydraulic and pneumatic systems, wet scrubbers, valves and control instrumentation. The work is performed under the supervision of the Chief of Maintenance. Does related work as required.

Candidates will not have to take an exam for this title. This is a Hiring Emergency Limited Placement (HELP) Program-designated title. The HELP Program is a temporary program designed to help local government employers address current staffing issues.
