In this position, the person will develop and implement the strategic vision and priorities of the Legislative Black Caucus (LBC). This position will lead the day-to-day operations of the LBC while serving as a liaison to County departments and ensuring the LBC's priorities are integrated into all County planning and operations. Additionally, the Director of Strategic Planning will oversee all aspects of the LBC's operations, including staffing, budgeting, programming, and building relationships with key community partners. The ideal candidate is a forward-thinking, organized leader with excellent verbal and written communication skills and the ability to manage multiple priorities. Additionally, they must excel at relationship building and working collaboratively with diverse groups of people. This is a management-level position that operates within the Office of the Chair and reports to the Chief of Staff.
