MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: EITHER:

B. Graduation from high school or possession of a GED and ten (10) years as a police investigator or as a sworn law enforcement officer whose primary function involves investigating cases of juvenile offenders, child abuse, interfamily offenders, and domestic violence.
