DESCRIPTION:

The instructor will administer the Nurse Aide Training Program at Shaker Place. This includes providing in-person classroom training to nurse aide training program students, supervising nurse aide training program students for required clinical experience and organizing the nurse aide training program in accordance with the New York state Training Program curriculum.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a New York State Registered Professional Nurse with two (2) years of nursing experience of which one (1) year was in a nursing home or long-term care facility and one of the following: *EITHER*:

- A. Certification by the NYS Department of Education to teach nurse aides or practical nursing; *OR*,
- B. Licensure as a trade school teacher of nurse aides; *OR*,
- C. Completion of a professionally-recognized course in teaching adult learners; *OR*,
- D. Two (2) years of experience teaching nursing or nursing-related programs to adults in an academic setting approved by the State Education Department or other recognized accrediting body.

Candidates will not have to take an exam for this title. This is a Hiring Emergency Limited Placement (HELP) Program-designated title. The HELP Program is a temporary program designed to help local government employers address current staffing issues. Traditionally, the titles filled under the HELP Program required job candidates to compete in a competitive exam to be considered for employment. For the duration of the program, this title will be classified as non-competitive and categorized as a "HELP Program" position. At the close of the program, this position will revert to competitive class status. Employees occupying positions filled through the HELP Program will be granted competitive class status without the need to participate in a competitive exam.
