Integrated Clinic:

This is a professional nursing position involving the responsibility for the care and treatment of behavioral health (mental health and alcohol/substance abuse) patients. Incumbent in this class perform specialized nursing care using judgment and skill. Work is performed under the general direction of a superior in accordance with a prescribed nursing care plan. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from a school of nursing approved by the State Education Department from a course approved by such department as qualifying for Registered Professional Nurse and one (1) years of nursing experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Possession of a license issued by the State of New York to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse at the time of appointment and throughout employment.

Candidates will not have to take an exam for this title. This is a Hiring Emergency Limited Placement (HELP) Program-designated title. The HELP Program is a temporary program designed to help local government employers address current staffing issues. Traditionally, the titles filled under the HELP Program required job candidates to compete in a competitive exam to be considered for employment. For the duration of the program, this title will be classified as non-competitive and categorized as a "HELP Program" position. At the close of the program, this position will revert to competitive class status. Employees occupying positions filled through the HELP Program will be granted competitive class status without the need to participate in a competitive exam.
